the Rio Coco river from Waspsam.

Solimar was living with her aunt because both her parents have died. But now her aunt can no longer provide for her.

Yorbany's parents are still living, but like Solimar's aunt, they can no longer provide for even Yorbany's basic needs. There was no hope for either of these girls for a future or for even a basic education.

But no longer will these girls need to live in fear, wondering where they are going to live and what they are going to eat.

When they arrived in El Crucero, neither Solimar or Yorbany could speak a

word of Spanish. Grace has been helping them to learn Spanish as she plays with them.

Both girls arrived with lice in their hair and their stomachs full of parasites. We immediately took care of both needs.

Last week Solimar and Yorbany both began first grade in our school in El Crucero. It is amazing to see how happy they are to be here at New Hope!

Since these two little girls were in need of immediate attention, we felt we should not wait to first find sponsors. But now we urgently need sponsors to help take care of the extra expenses of having these girls in House of Hope.

One person could co-sponsor one of these girls for \$50 a month. A church, or a Sunday class could give \$150 a month to sponsor one of these girls. Thanks for agreeing with us in prayer for the \$300 a month needed to take care of the needs of both girls at House of Hope.
