We have needed to expand our present children's home ever since God provided the finances to purchase it.

GROUND BREAKING FOR OUR BOY'S HOME

A few days ago, a Nicaraguan director for homeless children stopped by to see the home New Hope is providing for our homeless children. After looking everything over, she noticed how clean, well behaved and happy our children are. At a time when Americans are not allowed to open a children's home in Nicaragua (and the government is closing children's homes), she decided New Hope would be a good place for two little boys, ages five and seven.

As much as we would have loved to say, "Bring the boys here immediately, the truth is, New Hope has no space. Besides, at this time, New Hope is having to put the girls and boys together in one house.

After Charity shared with her father, Brother Ford, what transpired, he said, "It's time to rise and build!"

Without the first dollar towards the construction, plans were made to lay-out the building and begin construction by Monday!

So the plans were drawn, and even before the first workman could turn a shovel full of dirt, the first donation of \$5,000 was received to be used on the building! Now instead of just digging the footing (with no finances towards the project), the footing can be finished and the walls can begin to go up.

The new building will have room to comfortably house twelve boys, as well as, provide a much needed new kitchen and dining area for both children's homes. The old kitchen and dining area in the existing home will be remodeled so another six girls can be accommodate.

Thanks for your PRAYER OF AGREEMENT for the necessary finances to provide 18 children with their first real home. To God be the glory!!!

Today Leo and Charity are flying to Waspam to officially open the only children's home in the rain forest After much consideration and prayer, we felt at New Hope that we must provide a very much needed place of safety, love and security for the many homeless and physically and sexually abused Miskito Indian children who live in the most remote area of Nicaragua.

Besides establishing a "place of refuge" for these unfortunate children, a door has opened to the only secondary school in this area to evangelize the over one-thousand children attending that school. The principal has invited our New Hope team to come and teach their children God's Word.

Thanks for your PRAYER OF AGREEMENT for the finances needed to rent a home and furnish it, to purchase a truck, as well as, a boat and motor that is needed to go up and down the Rio Coca River to rescue the children in need. We praise the Lord that \$700 has already been given towards this vital project!
