Two years ago, God placed it on the hearts of Ryan and Joslynn Heath to adopt three brothers, Melios, Rosendo and Beto. On Thursday the long adoption process came to an end when these three brothers left Nicaragua for the United States with their new mother, Joslynn. They are now officially U.S. citizens!

Melios, Rosendo and Beto have been with us at House of Hope for the last five years. How time goes

by. I remember the day I led a team up river and received these three boys from their grandfather. I did not know at that time that the day would come when they would be leaving us for the U.S.. God definitely had a plan! These three brothers are truly blessed!

We are definitely going to miss them! They were a part of our family here. But we are also happy for them because we know they are in good hands and will be truly cared for and loved. What new experiences and opportunities lie ahead of them... only God knows!

Those of us who are left behind at House of Hope are adjusting to life without them. They all wrote Leo and me letters when they left. But the oldest brother, fifteen year old Melios, wrote a very touching letter. I will quote a part of it here:

"Brother Leo and Charity if you all hadn't taken me from my home, my life would have been very difficult like other people on the Atlantic Coast. But God is big and he put me in your hands to prepare me with my education and to give me counsel for my life. Thank you for showing me love and affection... You will always be in my heart... God Bless"

Please keep these boys in your prayers as they begin a new journey in their lives and begin to adjust to life in the United States. We love you Melios, Rosendo and Beto!
