Thanksgiving Day has come and gone. We pray you enjoyed a wonderful day and a

special meal with your family and friends. We also pray you have many things, big and little, for which to be thankful.

If you and your family had turkey and all the trimmings, you had a meal that most Nicaraguan people can only dream about. They would feel blessed if they were to have some chicken, or even beans. The price of beans has gone so high, that most families in Nicaragua can not afford to buy them. This means their main food is rice (and sometimes they don’t even have rice).

According to recent statistics, 79.9% of the population of Nicaragua live on less than \$2 a day and 45% of the population live on less than \$1 a day. With this in mind, it is easy to see why many of the children we work with, look to New Hope for not only an education, but

some of their food as well. Though one meal a day may not sound like much to us, to these children, the meal they receive every day they come to school, means a great deal.

Many children in Nicaragua are “forgotten children.” They do not know who or where their father is. They hardly see their mothers, as they are out working, trying to put food on the table. This is why many of these children are growing up with little or no supervision or care. All of their lives they are neglected.

We have children attending our school who feel that since no one

else cares whether they live or die... they too, have given up on living.

Charity has been working with some of our girls in high school who are so overwhelmed with the problems they are facing, they have been contemplating suicide.

These “Chosen Girls” (name of group), are meeting with Charity regularly, so they can learn to follow Christ and how to cope with these dramatic situations they are facing every day in their homes.

problem in Nicaragua. Though these precious children may be forgotten and neglected by man, the good news is they are never forgotten by God... or New Hope.

Be assured that my family and I take none of the finances you give New Hope. We still take care of our own airplane tickets and other travel

expenses, etc. No Americans receive even one dollar for our time and work with these children. It is a 100% labor of love.

My wife Rose has been in Nicaragua during the last month, and will not be coming back to the states until the middle of December. The Lord willing, I will return to Nicaragua the middle of January.

**CHARITY AND LAUREN ARE IN THE RAINFOREST RESCUING CHILDREN**

They are at New Hope children's home in Waspam, working with Miskito Indian children. As usual, the needs are greater than our resources.

One of the children who came to

their attention was Ruby. She is 12 years old and weighs about 15-20 pounds. Ruby has never walked and she cannot talk. She jumped



into Charity and Lauren's arms ready to go with them. Ruby is an extreme case of malnutrition and other health problems.

Three other children were rescued and placed in House of Hope in Waspam.

Elvis is 8 years old, his sister Delmi (standing next to him) is 10 years old. These two children do not have a mother and do not know their father. The other little girl is Jasmine. Her parents died.

Little Billy's mother is only 16. She has no way to take care of him. We plan on taking him from New Hope's home in Waspam along with little Samari to our home in El Crucero. Samari is ex-

cited because she will be reunited with her brother Frankie (who is already at El Crucero).
